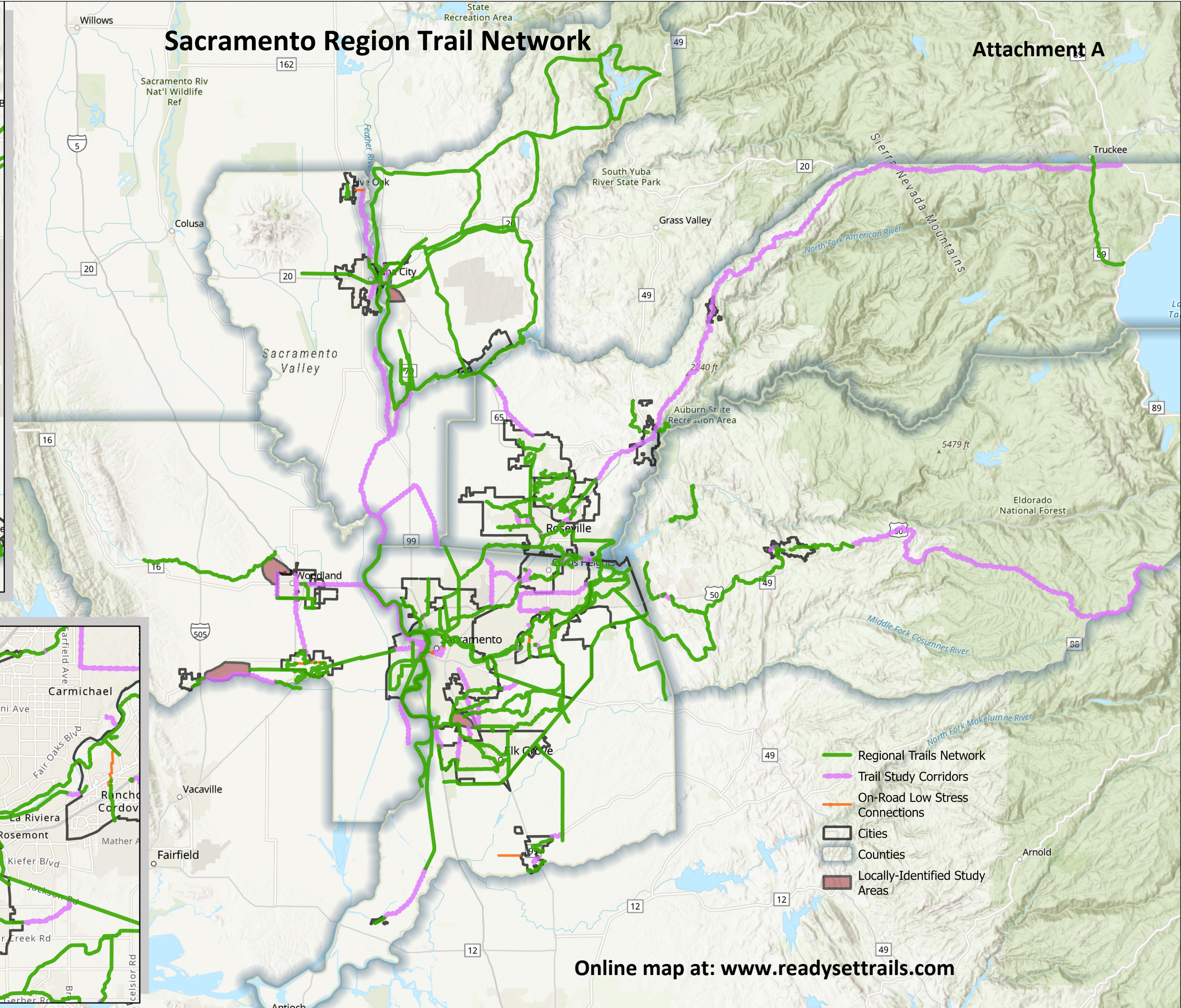
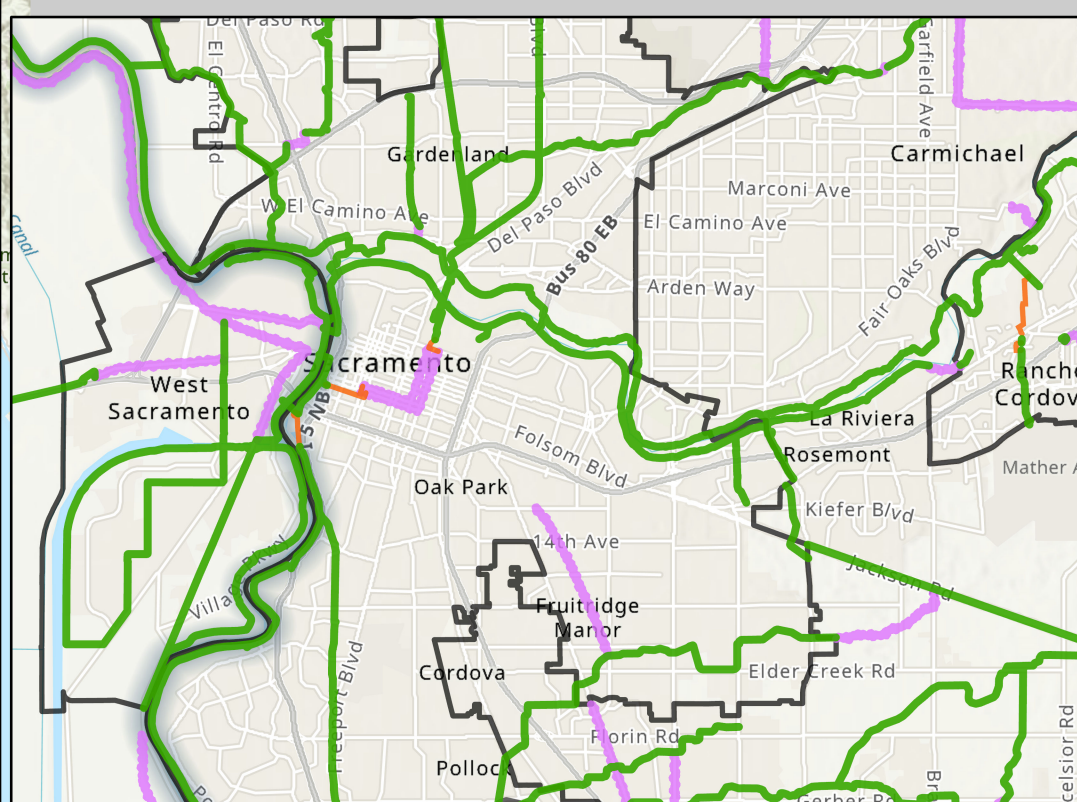
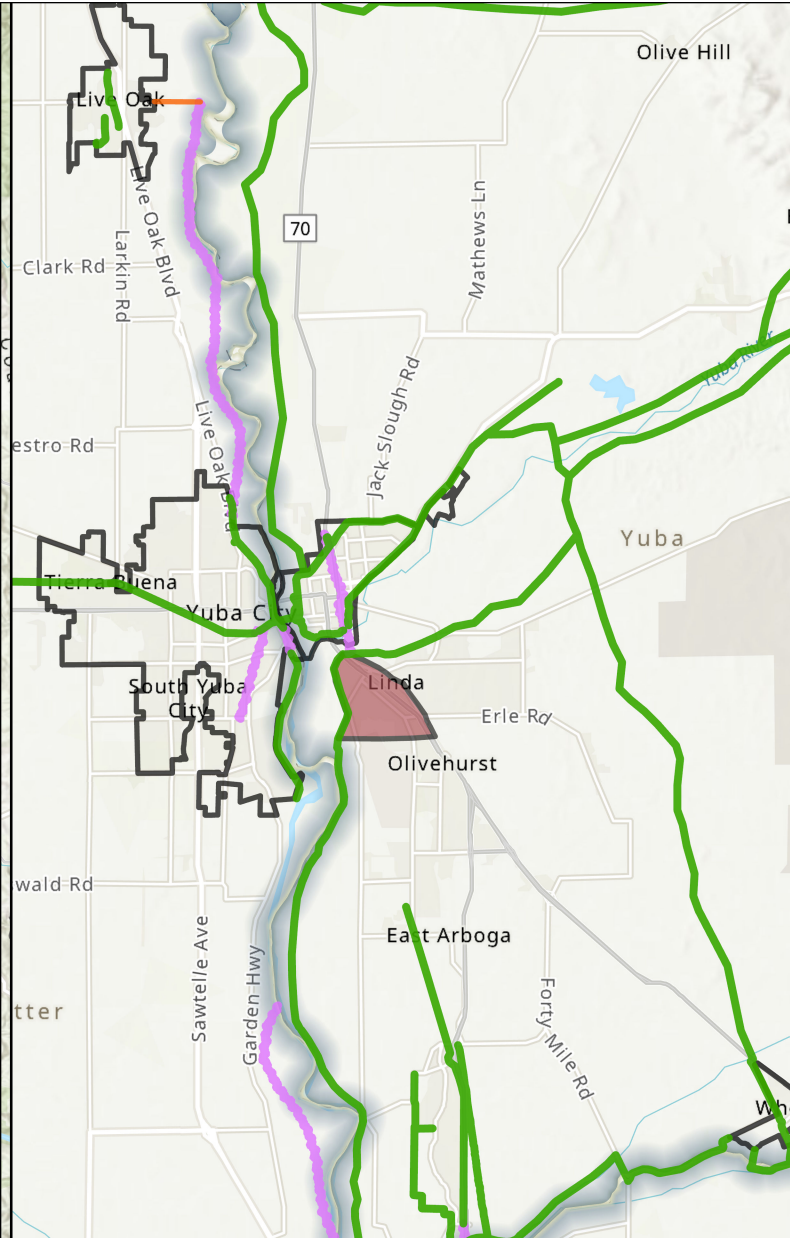

Prioritizing the Regional Trail Network with Qualitative Metrics

The regional trail network focuses on equitably creating regional trail connectivity and increasing access to the destinations that support the vitality and livability of the region. The majority of the identified connections (over 250 miles of existing trails and more than 800 miles of planned trails) are selected from local plans for their potential to make connections across boundaries in the region. Over 300 miles of trail study corridors—connections identified for further study in future planning documents, planned connections with known implementation challenges, and high-concept connections—are also identified for their potential to connect via trails or trail-like facilities across the region.

Early in the plan development, local partner input identified four challenges for regional trail network implementation: institutional barriers, meaningful community engagement, infrastructure barriers, and siloed local planning efforts and development. While all four challenges need to be addressed to develop a trail network that meets regional goals and resident needs, **institutional barriers** (coordinating with multiple implementing partners or rights-of-way owners) and **infrastructure barriers** (crossing freeways or rivers) were highlighted as areas where a regional approach could help advance local efforts.

The role of prioritization

The prioritization framework aims to identify the trails with strong potential to help meet regional plan goals. It also serves as a tool to uncover where regional coordination efforts could be focused. Local partners shared those projects involving infrastructure barriers and institutional barriers have previously been shelved or never started because they were thought to be too complex or too expensive for one agency to pursue, even if there may be great benefits.

Not every project will have a need for regional coordination—some projects are further along in their development and partner coordination; others may be entirely within one jurisdiction’s public right-of-way and not require implementing partners. However, SACOG staff effort may be needed to help other multijurisdictional or multi-partner projects advance to achieve regional connectivity and address the institutional and infrastructure barriers.

Phase 1 – Envisioned benefits of the project

In June 2021, the board reviewed performance targets to measure progress towards the six trail network goals. The performance targets were developed by coupling the goals of the trail network with the local partner input and the public engagement learnings from the spring 2021 outreach survey. SACOG worked with local partners to identify a regional trail network connecting communities across the six counties of the Sacramento region and would positively contribute towards those targets. Seventy percent of the prioritization weight is assigned to the potential trail’s ability to further the region’s progress towards the plan’s performance metrics. The remaining thirty percent of prioritization looks at how trails could advance regional efforts and capture performance potential outside of the plan-specific measures, based on board and partner input.

The two categories within the prioritization allow for different combinations of goals to capture the full score. By “stacking” goals and progress towards the performance metrics, it decreases the expectation that a trail or connection must further every potential goal to be of value to the regional network. For example, a trail segment could earn the maximum weight of 30 percent under Regionalism with the goals of *Collaboration* and *Strengthening the Network*; with *Strengthening the Network* and *Critical*

Access; or with *Collaboration* and *Critical Access*. A project that furthered the goals of all three Regionalism goals would also earn the maximum weight of 30 percent.

Phase 2 – Identifying the next steps for implementation

The regional trail network includes planned trails and conceptual connections at different stages of development. The readiness criteria are used as a roadmap to identify where a potential trail is in its project development lifecycle and identify the next needed stages to move similar projects forward.

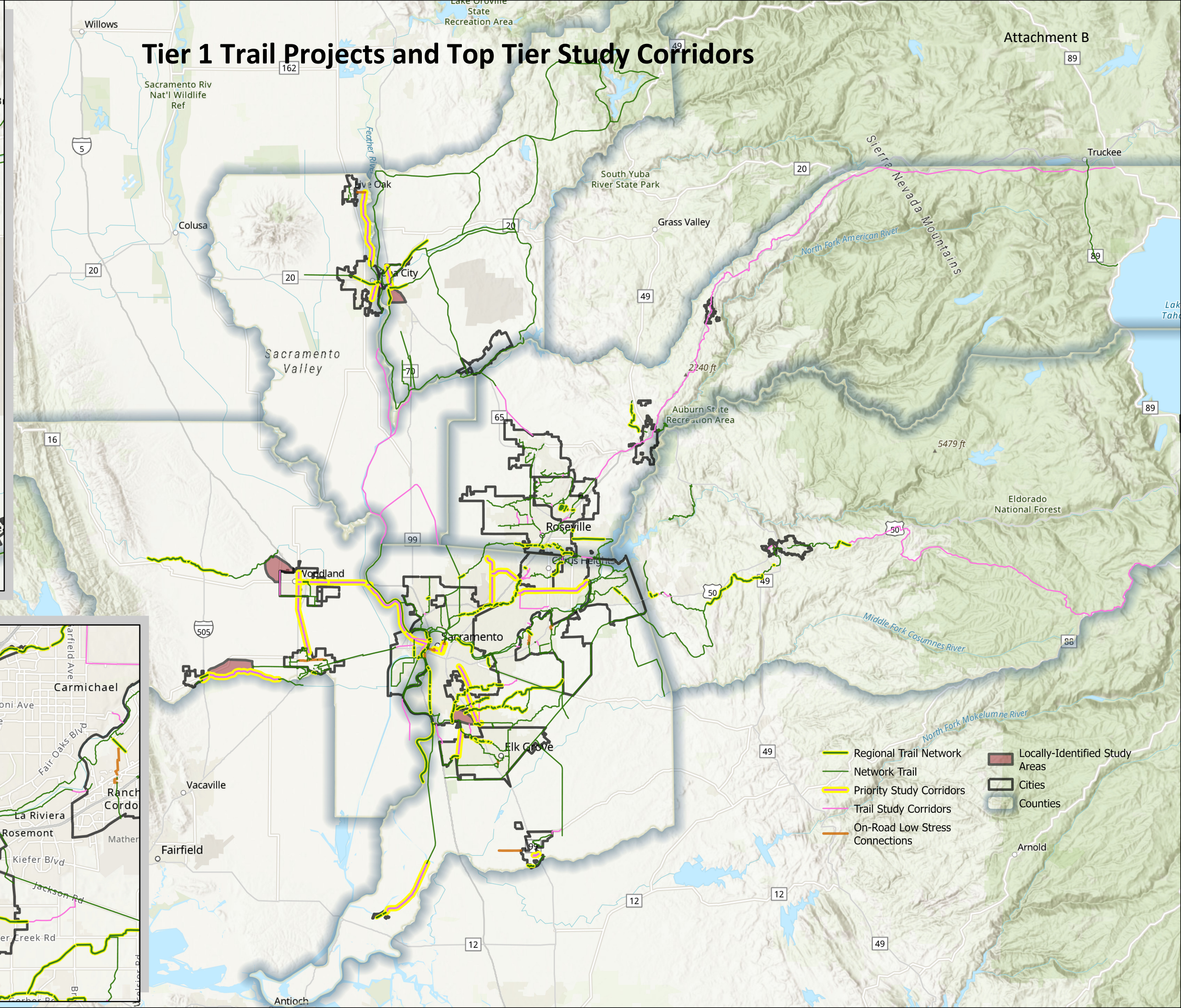
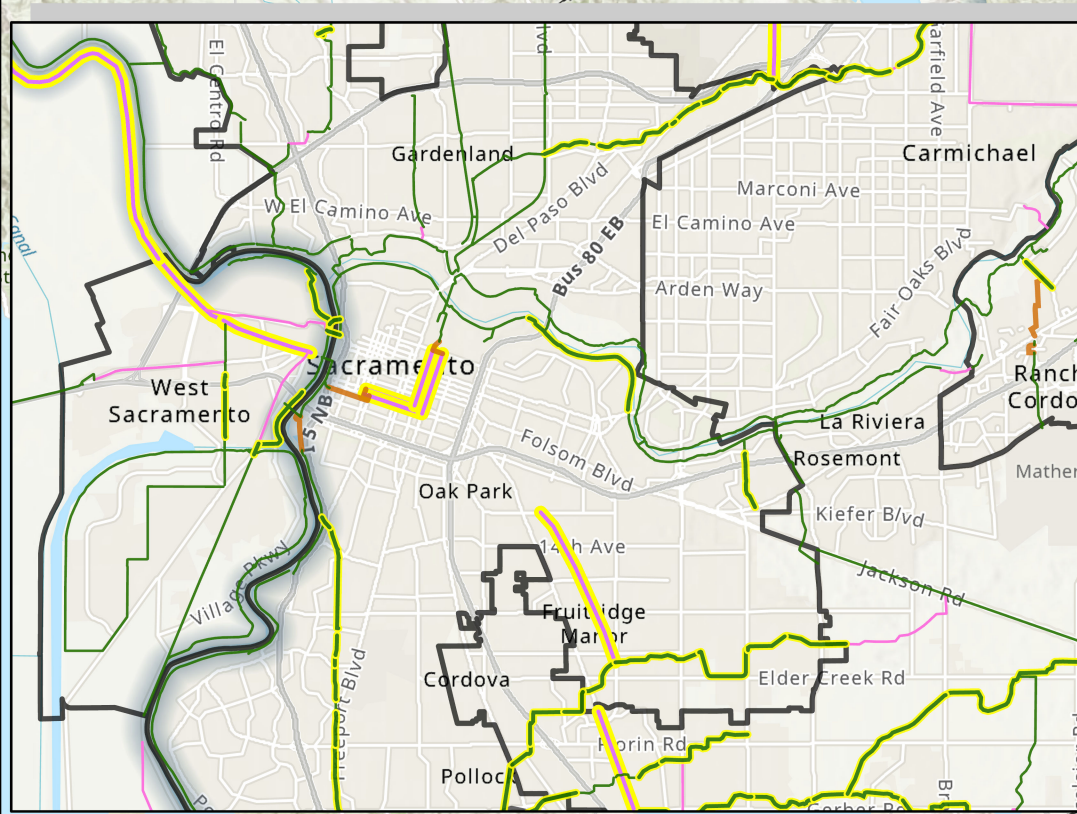
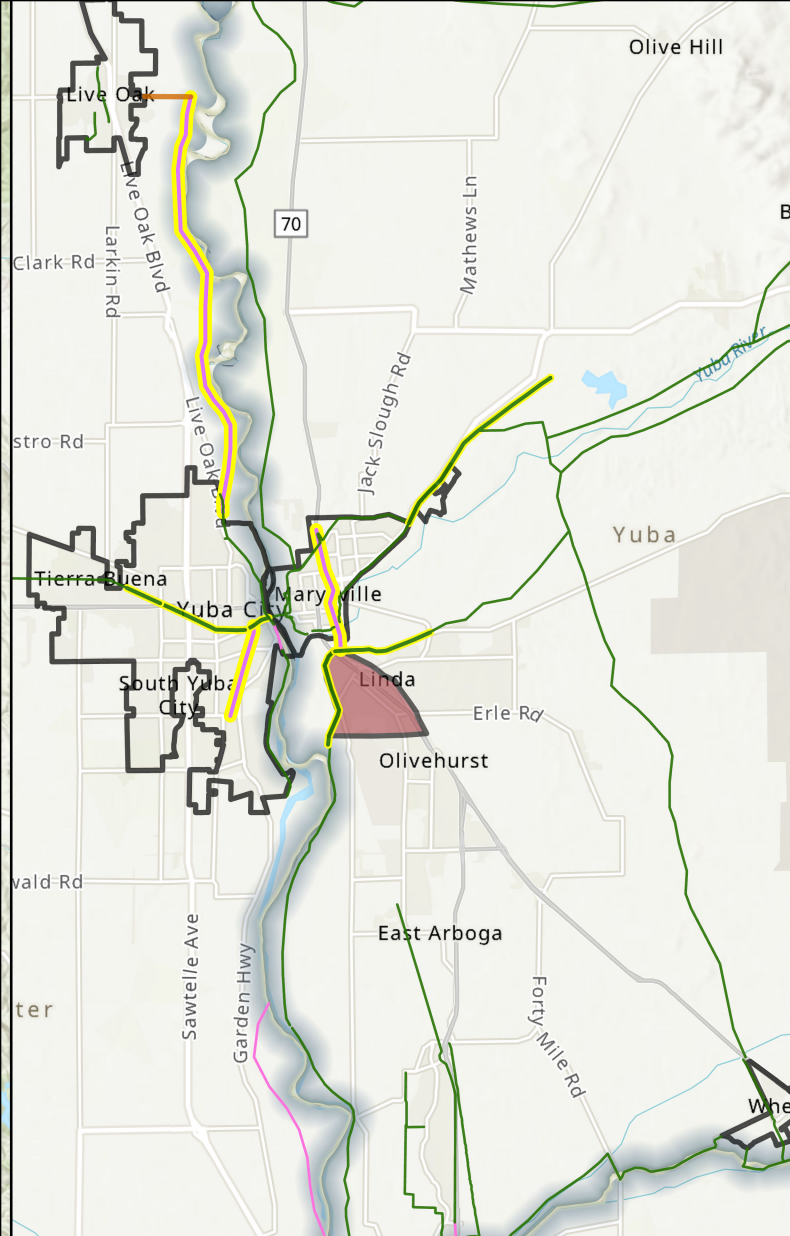
