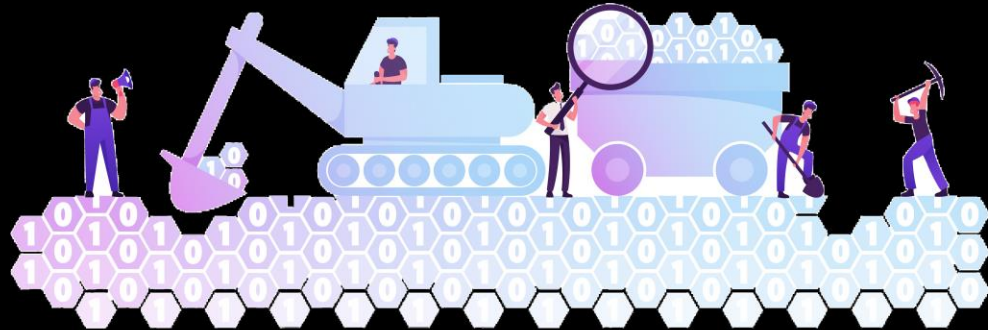
Open Data is accessible

- Users know the licensing information



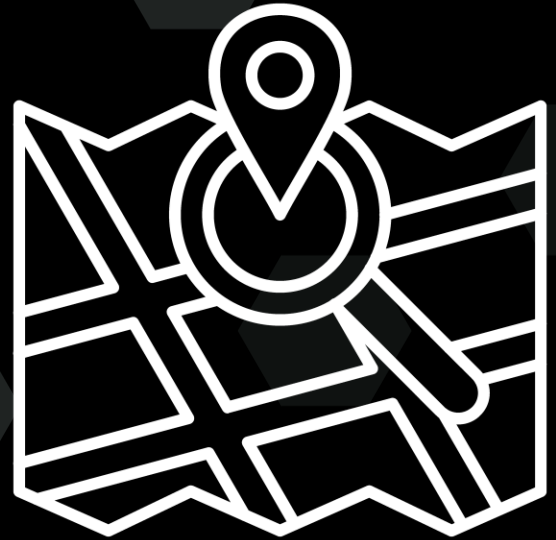
Open Data is discoverable
