Equipment is currently located in West Sacramento and must be picked up by the recipient. Neither SACOG nor the City of West Sacramento assumes liability for the equipment after it is picked up by the interested party.

About the Equipment



Information Panel Frames

These steel frames, finished with a corrosion-resistant coating, are designed for wayfinding or other informational signage.

- Note: You will need to design and supply your own metal signage inserts; you are receiving the frame only.
- Dimensions: 72"H × 11.5"W × 4"D (183 × 29 × 10 cm)
- Estimated value: \$1,250 each
- Color: Grey (undecorated)

Bike Racks

These steel racks, also corrosion-resistant, can be installed on pavement or concrete to support safe bike parking. If installed without obstructing sightlines, bike racks could also support adherence with California's daylighting law (AB 413), stipulating that no vehicle parking is allowed within 20 feet of a marked or unmarked crosswalk.

- Dimensions: 69.2"H × 19.1"W × 18"L (176 × 49 × 46 cm)
- Estimated value: \$166 each
- Color: Grey (undecorated)



Please review the FAQs below to determine whether you'd like to submit a request.

Q: Am I eligible to request equipment?

- Yes, if your business, organization, or jurisdiction is located in El Dorado, Placer, Sacramento, Sutter, Yolo, or Yuba County. Unfortunately, requests from outside these counties cannot be accommodated.

Q: Is there a minimum or maximum number of information panel frames or bike racks that I can request?

- There is no minimum or maximum limit at this time. You will be asked to provide a photo of your intended installation location when submitting your request.

Q: I want to install a lot of bike racks; will I get all of the bike racks I request?

- Bike racks and information panels will be prioritized for public agencies, then community-serving organizations, and then businesses. However, there will likely be enough bike racks and information panels to meet all requests.

Q: Will SACOG or the City of West Sacramento install the equipment for me?

- No. Recipients are responsible for their own installation.

Q: Where can I install the equipment?

- Anywhere you have permission to do so, provided the bike racks remain publicly accessible once installed. Please consult your local permitting requirements before proceeding.

Q: Do I need a permit to install the equipment?

- Permitting requirements vary by jurisdiction. We recommend contacting your jurisdiction's planning and building department.
- For example, West Sacramento does not require a building permit for these installations, but a signage permit may be required, and if the sign is installed in public right-of way, an encroachment may be required.

Q: What materials do I need for installation?

- Tools, bolts, and fasteners are not included and must be sourced separately. Required hardware depends on your installation surface:
 - If you are installing on concrete (e.g., a sidewalk), you will need these materials:
 - Tanner Bolt 50N400ABS 1/2" x 4" Button Head Tamper-Resistant Secure-Bolt Sleeve Anchors ([link to product](#), \$132/box of 25)
 - Stainless Steel Post Zinc Pltd. Anchor Body, #55 Torx Security Drive ([link to product](#), \$175/box of 25).
 - If you are installing on pavement (e.g., a former parking spot), you will need these materials:
 - Timcoloc™ 16x100 Asphalt Fasteners, carbon steel with a surface treatment of zinc aluminum flake ([link to product](#), \$73.43/box of 10)

Q: Can I decorate or paint the equipment?

- Yes. Once the equipment is in your possession, your organization, local artists, schools, or other interested parties are welcome to decorate or brand it.
- Note: Info panel frames do not include signage. You will need to design and supply your own metal signage inserts; you are receiving the frame only.
